

The *Pedilanthus tithymaloides* or 'Devil'S backbone' is a plant of the cactus species with a zigzagged stalk. The stalk is dark green and tapers. It indeed looks remarkable. This plant occurs naturally in the dryer regions of South and Middle America. *Pedilanthus tithymaloides* is sold as a plant with roots or with its stalks cut. The stalks can be placed in a vase like cut flowers and will live for a long time. Beware: this plant'S white fluids are slightly toxic and after contact with you should wash your hands thoroughly. Plantcare

The succulent species *Pedilanthus tithymaloides* likes being in a bright spot. If the plant is bought with roots, it needs very little water. If it was bought with cut stalks, it is best to place this exotic plant in a case with a bit of plant food and water, or in a pot with some soil, so *Pedilanthus* can start to grow. Maintain room temperature or a bit above it. The best soil for *Pedilanthus tithymaloides* is a mixture of sand and cactus potting soil.
