Pachypodium succulentum is a slow growing, drought-loving plant that is appreciated for its unusual appearance. The flowers are also beautiful, but unfortunately the plant does not bloom often as a houseplant. During drought and high temperatures the plant drops the leaves and has a strangely shaped trunk that resembles a starting termite mound. New shoots have fresh green leaves
