The caudex (tuber) of the Euphorbia trichadenia can be 6 to 20 centimeters wide. Every year green shoots with leaves sprout from the tuber which looks like a large cork-like barked rootstock. The flowers from this Euphorbia trichadenia are very special, yellow in color and with a beautiful crowned edge.
