Butia eriospatha (feather palm) is a Brazilian palm that grows at a great height and is therefore fairly frost-resistant. In nature, Butia eriospatha develops brown fluffy tubes that cover the blossom. It is mainly grown in South America for its edible, tasty fruits.

Butia eriospatha is native to Brazil. This feather palm grows at altitudes of 1000 meters above sea level making it used to cold wet winters and suitable to our northern European climate, with a frost resistance of up to -10° degrees. This species is still relatively undiscovered."
