The *Dionaea muscipula* 'Freaky star' owes its name to two unique external features. First of all the traps are star-shaped and have thick, fleshy edges lined with rows of teeth in some cases even with double rows of teeth. Secondly the fleshy stalks sprout uncontrollably out of the soil winding their way pell-mell upwards. The *Dionaea muscipula* 'Freaky star' originates from Europe, but looks more like it has come from a far, undisturbed region where the craziest mutations can take place. The *Dionaea muscipula* 'Freaky star' is because of its unique appearance a real star among the Venus fly-traps with a bizarre edge.
