The *Drosera felix* can be kept in either a peat-sand-perlite mix or in a sphagnum (peat moss)-perlite mixture. Like most South American species, it loves a high light intensity, high humidity and high daytime temperature (about 23 ° C). Ensure that the nighttime temperature drops to 15 degrees.
