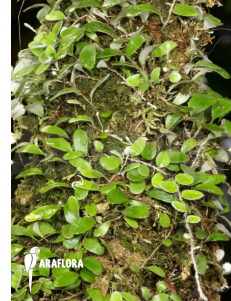








Creeping button fern 'Pyrrosia nummularifolia' (Fern&87a)

Pyrrosia nummularifolia is a delightful little fern. In a tropical terrarium or paludarium the Pyrrosia nummularifolia is a great addition. With sufficient light and moisture, this small fern will start climbing a trunk or backwall. Once Pyrrosia nummularifolia, it gives the whole a natural look.

Product info

The tropical forests of South-East Asia form the original range of Pyrrosia nummularifolia. There, this small fern grows on tree trunk. Its growth is creeping. With its small rootlets, this Pyrrosia attaches itself to a surface. This fern can be found together with mosses and orchids. In its original natural surroundings, this plant grows in bright spots. Pyrrosia nummularifolia is found in this habitat of various agames such as Calotes and Acanthosaura.

Plantcare

Provide *Pyrrhosia nummulariifolia* the option of creeping. This can be facilitated by placing the plant on a backwall (preferably of fern root) or on an epiphyte trunk. Fertilization is not immediately required. Make sure the roots don't dry out. To this end, place a moist soil substrate (for example peat or cocos peat). Optionally, wrap the roots and the soil substrate in Sphagnum to place the fern on an epiphyte branch. *Pyrrhosia nummulariifolia* is also suitable for in a tropical terrarium or paludarium.
