The *Drosera adelae* is one of three species of sundew that grow in Queensland, Australia. Its sword-shaped leaves can grow longer than 20 centimetres and seem, at first glance identical to those of *Drosera regia*. Depending on the amount of light, the *Drosera* will form red oblong leaves or broad green leaves.
