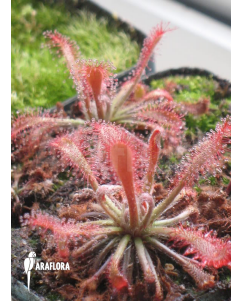


Sundew 'Drosera oblanceolata'; (CarniDr53)

Drosera oblongeolata is best cultivated in a mixture of silica-sand, peat and perlite. The sundew will thrive when kept on a windowsill or in a terrarium with artificial lighting. Ensure proper humidity and warmth for optimal growth.
